

PVA ACRYLICS MULTIPURPOSE

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

New generation water based economic, Matt coating for walls and ceilings.

PRODUCT FEATURES

- Excellent, no mess application properties.
- · Good opacity/hiding power.
- Interior/Exterior.
- · Low odour.

APPLICATION AREAS

• Plaster, Hardboard and Fibre cement ceilings/walls.

SURFACE PREPARATION

Uncoated concrete surfaces: Remove all dust, foreign material, Fungal, algae growth, fill and seal all visible cracks.

Uncoated weathered or new fibre cement surfaces: Remove dust, foreign material, Fungal, Algae growth and if friable, powdery seal with Heritage bonding liquid.

Raw Plaster: Remove all dust, foreign material, Fungal and Algae growth. Fill and seal all visible substrate cracks.

Previously Painted Surfaces: Remove all loose, flaking and bubbling paint. Remove all dust, foreign material, Fungus and Algae growth. Allow to dry, if then powdery or friable seal with Heritage bonding liquid.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- Always stir well before use.
- Brush, roller or airless spray apply a generous coat of Heritage Multi Purpose to the area, which needs protecting.
- Allow to dry 2-3 hours before recoating.
- Brush, roller or airless spray apply a second generous coat.

GENERAL

- Do not apply before 9am and after 4 pm in the Winter.
- Do not apply exterior if it looks like rain will occur with in 4-6 hours of application.
- Heritage Multipurpose is ready for use un-thinned, thinning with water will reduce its hiding power.
- Two coats of Heritage are required to give best results
- Although the spreading rate will vary with porosity and type of substrate. For uncoated new work on 5-7 SQM/I for the first coat and 8-10 SQM/I for subsequent coats and for when applied to sealed, previously painted substrates.
- Application equipment clean up is with clean tap water.

COLOUR RANGE & QUANTITIES

- Available in 1, 5, 20 litres.
- Mostly white but Pastel colours can be tinted from white.

PRECAUTIONS

- Heritage Multipurpose is not flammable.
- It contains no toxic substances.
